Food Recall Warning – Sliced apples and products containing sliced apples recalled due to Listeria monocytogenes

Attention: Long-Term Care Homes, Rest and Retirement Homes, Hospitals, Child Care Facilities

Date: May 1, 2015

This fax is to notify you that the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) has issued a food recall warning for sliced apples and products containing sliced apple due to the possibility of it containing Listeria monocytogenes.

It is our understanding that these products may have been distributed in Ontario. A copy of this information should be directed to your dietary departments to ensure that the facility food supply has been checked, and any affected product is identified and removed from service.

The MOHLTC is asking institutions to inform anyone who may have consumed the product to monitor themselves for signs and symptoms of listeriosis and seek medical attention if any symptoms are experienced.

Symptoms of listeriosis can include vomiting, nausea, persistent fever, muscle aches, severe headache and neck stiffness. Pregnant women, the elderly and people with weakened immune systems are particularly at risk. Although infected pregnant women may experience only mild, flu-like symptoms, the infection can lead to premature delivery, infection of the newborn or even stillbirth. In severe cases of illness, people may die.
