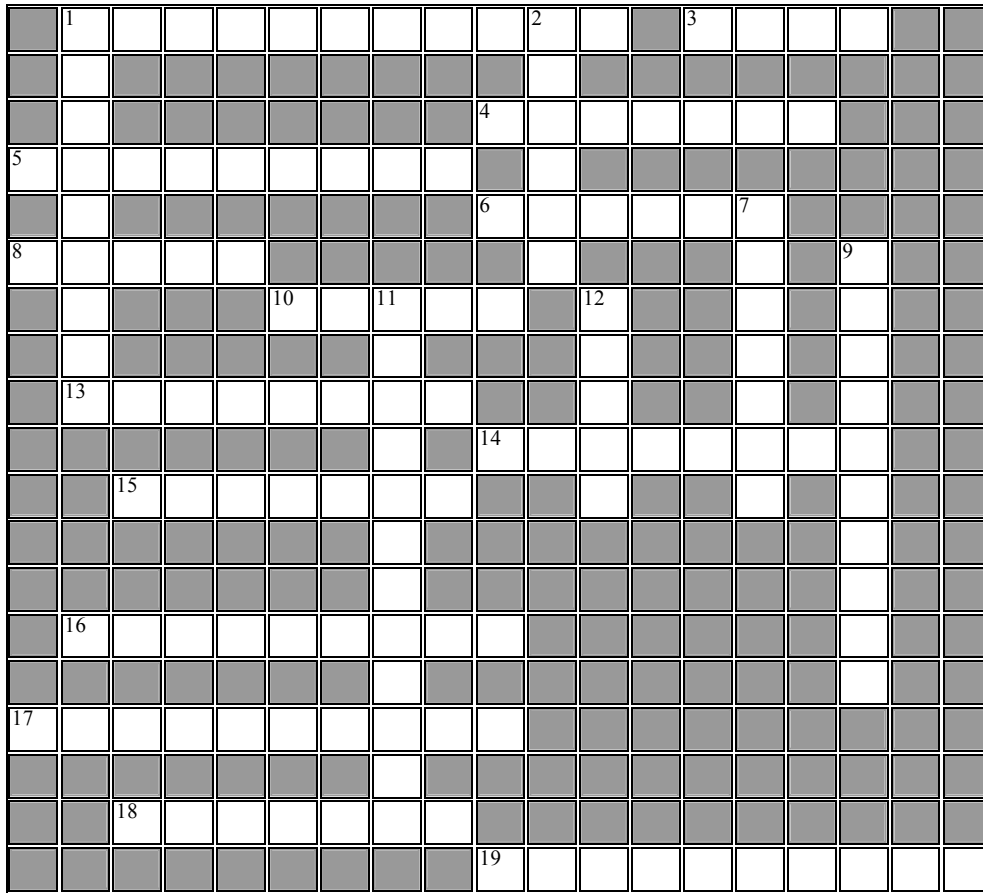


## Hepatitis B Crossword Puzzle

## **Activity #1: Student Worksheet - Facts You Should Know**

Use the vocabulary words listed below to complete the following statements about your liver and Hepatitis B.

### **Cirrhosis, Immunization, Liver, Antibodies, Jaundice, Hepatitis**

A healthy \_\_\_\_\_ fights infections and helps to stop bleeding. It helps to digest food and removes some waste products from your body. It stores energy for when you need it and helps to make sex hormones and adrenaline.

\_\_\_\_\_ is a liver disease that causes swelling and \_\_\_\_\_ (scarring), and prevents it from working as it must to keep your body healthy. In addition, the person's skin can become yellow (\_\_\_\_\_).

There are different types of Hepatitis – each one has a different cause and has a different effect on the person's body. All are the same in that they cause inflammation (suffix "itis") of the liver (prefix "hep").

One way to protect yourself is to get an \_\_\_\_\_. This stimulates a person's body to produce \_\_\_\_\_ that will detect the Hepatitis B virus and protect you from getting the disease.

Once a person has completed his or her immunizations for Hepatitis B, he or she does not usually require further immunization against Hepatitis B.
