

Disposable/Cloth Diapering Procedure



Gather needed supplies (wipes, disinfectant, diapers, creams, sanitizer etc.).



Wash hands with soap and water.

*If necessary, put on disposable gloves.



Remove diaper, clean the child, discard the wipes and:

a. If the diaper is disposable, discard.b. If the diaper is cloth, place it in a sealable bag without rinsing and send home.



Clean hands with a wipe and then use alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

*Discard gloves prior to cleaning hands if gloves were used. *Do not leave child unattended.



Dispense dedicated, per child creams/powders in a manner that prevents contamination of the rest of the container (i.e. no double dipping).



Diaper and dress the child.



Help the child wash their hands.



Clean then disinfect the diapering area for the next child.



Wash your hands with soap and water.
