

# Disposable/Cloth Diapering Procedure



1

Gather needed supplies (wipes, disinfectant, diapers, creams, sanitizer etc.).



2

Wash hands with soap and water.

\*If necessary, put on disposable gloves.



3

Remove diaper, clean the child, discard the wipes and:

- If the diaper is disposable, discard.
- If the diaper is cloth, place it in a sealable bag without rinsing and send home.



4

Clean hands with a wipe and then use alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

- \*Discard gloves prior to cleaning hands if gloves were used.
- \*Do not leave child unattended.



5

Dispense dedicated, per child creams/powders in a manner that prevents contamination of the rest of the container (i.e. no double dipping).



6

Diaper and dress the child.



7

Help the child wash their hands.



8

Clean then disinfect the diapering area for the next child.



9

Wash your hands with soap and water.
