

# Toileting Procedure

1



Gather required supplies.

2



Wash hands with soap and water.

\*If necessary, put on disposable gloves.

3



Remove or help child remove diaper/training pant, discard if soiled.

\*Place cloth diaper in a sealable bag without rinsing and send home.

4



After child has used toilet, use alcohol-based hand sanitizer. If hands are visibly soiled, wash with soap and water.

5



Help child finish dressing.

6



Help child wash their own hands with soap and water.



If toilet or potty become visibly dirty/soiled, wash then disinfect immediately (use PPE as needed). Wash hands again with soap and water.

**Note:** Stand up diapering should only take place in washrooms to reduce the chance of cross contamination.
