

Toileting Procedure



Gather required supplies.



Wash hands with soap and water. *If necessary, put on disposable gloves.



Remove or help child remove diaper/training pant, discard if soiled. *Place cloth diaper in a sealable bag without rinsing and send home.



After child has used toilet, use alcohol-based hand sanitizer. If hands are visibly soiled, wash with soap and water.



Help child finish dressing.



Help child wash their own hands with soap and water.



If toilet or potty become visibly dirty/soiled, wash then disinfect immediately (use PPE as needed). Wash hands again with soap and water.

Note: Stand up diapering should only take place in washrooms to reduce the chance of cross contamination.
