# Learning Centre #1

## ARE YOU UNDER THE INFLUENCE?

- students view commercials & public service announcements to identify the strategies marketers use (positive and negative)
- critical thinking
- media literacy





# Learning Centre #2

## JOINT FORCES

Students and police talk about current issues related to drugs, alcohol and the law.



## Learning Centre #3

# THE TRUTH ABOUT CONSEQUENCES

Students listen to a first-person story (live or recorded) about the impact that drug use and the choices related to that use have had on that person's life.



# Learning Centre #4

## WHEEL OF MISFORTUNE

Student teams compete in a game which helps to dispel common myths and reinforce factual information about alcohol, prescription drugs, marijuana and tobacco.

# Who You Gonna Call?

Students have an opportunity to meet professionals from local agencies and become familiar with the kinds of help available in the community.



# Learning Centre #6

## WRECK YOUR LIFE

- Students experience the sensation of being impaired and the impact it has on their ability to complete simple tasks
- Focus on alcohol poisoning

## DECISIONS, DECISIONS

Students practice decision-making in realistic scenarios...
