## **New Personal Service Setting** Physical Requirements (A minimum when opening a personal service setting)

Requirements - must be in compliance with Ontario Personal Service Settings Regulation R.R.O. 136/18 under the <i>Health Protection and Promotion Act</i> :	
	Notify SMDHU in writing of intention to operate, renovate or provide additional services at least 14 days in advance
	Submit architectural floor plans for review by SMDHU
	Adequate storage space, ventilation and lighting available for service and storage areas
	All surfaces (e.g. floors, walls, ceilings, tables, seats etc.) must be smooth, non-absorbent, and easy to clean
	Proper garbage/waste storage and removal (including biomedical and laundry)
	<ul> <li>Adequate supply of water is available</li> <li>municipal or private (treated and tested)</li> <li>potable hot and cold running water under pressure</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Hand wash sink used ONLY for hand washing provided and must be:</li> <li>conveniently located to service areas</li> <li>accessible at all times</li> <li>continually supplied with hot and cold running water under pressure</li> <li>have liquid soap and paper towel in dispensers</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Tool/equipment cleaning sink provided and must be:</li> <li>large enough to fit largest tool/equipment</li> <li>not be in the same room as a toilet</li> <li>have adequate counter space</li> <li>be separate from service areas</li> </ul>
	Sterilizers (autoclaves) must be approved by Health Canada and Canadian Standards Association
	Manufacturers' instructions for all disinfectants, sterilizers and equipment must be available onsite
	Disinfectants onsite must be approved by Health Canada, be labeled and have a:  • drug Identification Number (DIN) or Natural Product Number (NPN)
	Approved sharps containers onsite (if applicable)
	All construction must be completed and all requirements listed above must be in place prior to the opening inspections
