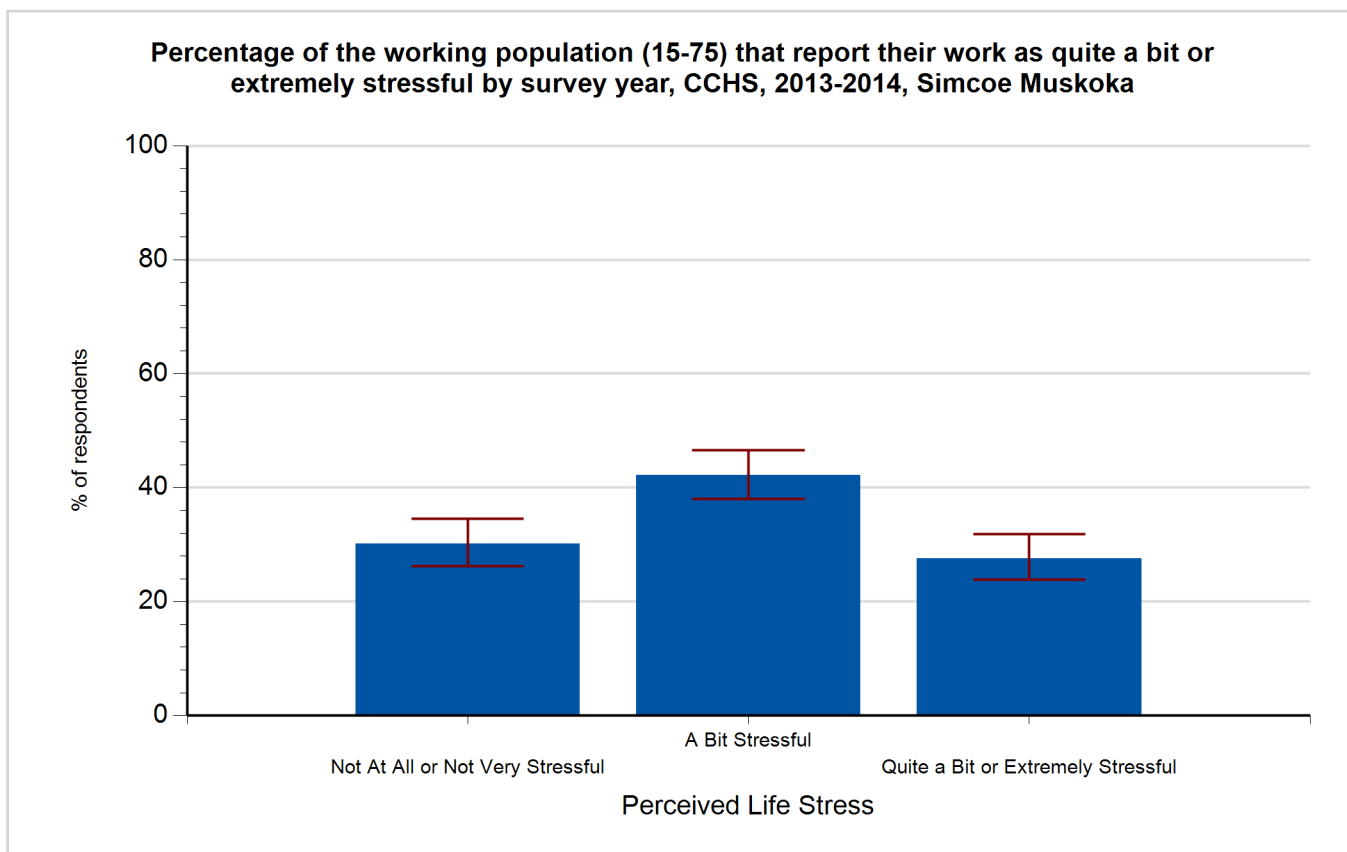



Percentage of the working population (15-75) that report their work as quite a bit or extremely stressful by survey year, CCHS 2013-2014, Simcoe Muskoka.

Proportion of the population between 15 years and 75 years that reported the amount of stress they perceive in their work, when answering the question: The next question is about your main job or business in the past 12 months. Would you say that most days at work are: not at all stressful, not very stressful, a bit stressful OR quite a bit stressful? This only includes respondents between 15 and 75 years that reported working at a job or business any time in the previous 12 months. Excludes respondents that answered 'don't know' or refused to any question.
