
## **STEP 4 c: Consider Tetanus**

## Assessment of Tetanus Immunization Status and Administration considerations between Tetanus and Rabies Vaccines and Immune Globulins





## **EXAMPLE** Rabies Vaccine **Administration Locations** Tetanus Ig Td/Tdap Vaccine (when required) At least 1" apart Consider Locations of NOTE: It is safe to Rabies Ig and administer Rabies **VACCINE** and Vaccine according to Vaccine and Tetanus Rabies Ig Recommendations for Ig should never vaccine in the same infiltrated Administration of be administered arm, at least 1" apart, according to Rabies Immune in the same site on the same date recommendations Globulin and Rabies NEVER into gluteal region Vaccine (Step 4a, 4b)

1. Client is Immune compromised...(e.g. HIV, agammaglobulinemia, hypogammaglobulinemia) Discuss if this is the same criteria as for Rabies- in which case use similar terminology
