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Pharmacy Influenza/COVID-19 Vaccine Update

Attention: Participating UIIP Pharmacies, Ontario Health Central, Ontario Health Teams, Municipalities

Date: February 8, 2024

- While demand for influenza and COVID-19 vaccine has decreased, pharmacies are encouraged to keep a small amount of inventory on hand to accommodate individuals who are still seeking vaccination.
- Any vaccine returned to the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit (SMDHU) at this point is considered wastage and we cannot re-circulate it.
- While pharmacies continue to have influenza and/or COVID-19 vaccine in the fridge, you must continue to monitor vaccine fridge temperatures twice daily and submit temperature logs to the SMDHU on a weekly basis.
- If your pharmacy no longer has influenza or COVID-19 vaccines in stock, and you will not be getting
 more supply from your distributor, you may discontinue submitting your temperature logs to the
 SMDHU weekly.
- A reminder that if at any time your vaccine fridge contains vaccine and the temperatures are outside of 2°C to 8°C, call 705-721-7520 Ext. 8806, as this could be a cold chain failure.
- Pharmacies may continue to administer influenza vaccine until the expiry date.
- All publicly funded COVID-19 and influenza vaccine that is not used by your pharmacy must be returned to the SMDHU. Returned vaccine must include a <u>Vaccine Return Form</u> which can be found on the <u>SMDHU website</u> under additional forms. Vaccine is to be returned to your local Health Unit office. It does not need to be maintained under cold chain.
