


Pneumococcal Immunization Recommendations for Adults over 65

All adults over the age of 65 are eligible for a dose of Pneu-P-23 vaccine (Pneumovax 23) publicly funded.

While the National Advisory Committee on Immunization (NACI) recommends Pneu-C-13 (Prevnar 13) vaccine for adults with immunocompromising conditions, it is only available publicly funded (free) in Ontario for those 50+ with specific conditions. See the box below for eligibility.

Prevnar 20 is not currently available publicly funded (free) in Ontario. Clients would have to purchase.

Eligibility for Publicly Funded High Risk Pneu-C-13 (50 years of age and older)

NO

- Congenital immunodeficiencies involving any part of the immune system, including B-lymphocyte (humoral) immunity, T-lymphocyte (cell) mediated immunity, complement system (properdin, or factor D deficiencies), or
- Immunocompromising therapy including use of long-term corticosteroids, chemotherapy,

radiation therapy, post-organ transplant therapy, biologic and certain antirheumatic drugs (1 dose)

- Malignant neoplasms including leukemia and lymphoma (1 dose)
- Sickle cell disease or other hemoglobinopathies (1 dose)
- Solid organ or islet cell transplant (candidate or recipient) (1 dose)
