

STEPS FOR



Toy Cleaning and Disinfection



Inspect & Collect

- **▼** Check toys for damage
- Remove toys from play area and take to cleaning and disinfection area



- Wash and scrub toys with soap and warm water
- Use small cleaning brushes to clean in hard-to-reach areas



Rinse with clean tap water



Air dry or dry with a clean cloth



Use a Health Canada approved disinfectant. Follow manufacturer's instructions*



Rinse with clean tap water



✓ Air dry or dry with a clean cloth



▼ Keep a record of when toys were cleaned and disinfected



*Dishwasher use is not the preferred method. If using dishwasher, ensure compliance with Ontario Food Premises Regulation R.R.O. 493/17. Do not use dishwasher to disinfect toys during an outbreak.

**Fully immerse toys in the disinfectant. For large toys, apply with a spray or cloth saturated with the disinfectant. Adhere to contact times as indicated on the product label.
