

COVID-19 IAW SETTING WORKER RISK ASSESSMENT TOOL: AM I A CLOSE CONTACT?

This flowchart is intended to be used by staff to assess their risk level if they have recently been in contact with a positive COVID-19 case and actions that should be taken based on the assessment.

When there is more than 1 case of COVID-19 in an employer provided living setting, all workers who live in the same setting as the case are considered high risk. START: Have been in contact with positive COVID-19 case **Low Risk** Were you within 2 metres of a COVID-19 case for at least a Continue with daily activities, NOcumulative duration of 15 minutes? including going to work Self-monitor for symptoms. High Risk Instructions:

Fully vaccinated and boosted - Do NOT need to self-isolate. Self-monitor for symptoms for 10 days after last exposure. PLUS for total of 10 days after last exposure wear a well-fitted mask in all public settings and in shared spaces inside home; avoid non-essential activities where mask removal necessary; avoid non-essential visits to highest risk settings; should not visit individuals who may be at higher risk of illness or immunocompromised.

Fully vaccinated - Self-isolate for at least 5 days after last exposure. Self-monitor for symptoms for 10 days after last exposure. PLUS for total of 10 days after last exposure wear a well-fitted mask in all public settings and in shared spaces inside home; avoid non-essential activities where mask removal necessary; avoid non-essential visits to highest risk settings; should not visit individuals who may be at higher risk of illness or immunocompromised.

Unvaccinated/partially vaccinated - Self-isolate and self-monitor for 10 days after last exposure in single room with separate bathroom and no shared spaces.

NOTE: High risk staff who have **previously tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days** (based on PCR or RAT) do NOT need to self-isolate. Self-monitor for symptoms for 10 days after last exposure. PLUS for total of 10 days after last exposure wear a well-fitted mask in all public settings and in shared spaces inside home. Can work in the highest-risk setting, as long as they are and remain asymptomatic.

If develop/have symptoms, self-isolate immediately and get tested.

*AGMP – aerosol generating medical procedure
