

# Disinfection Chart for Personal Service Settings

## DISINFECTING PIPELESS FOOTBATHS IN SPAS

All water remains within the footbath throughout service when using a pipeless footbath.

Always refer to the manufacturer's directions for the footbath regarding recommendations for cleaning and disinfecting.

### CLEANING AND DISINFECTING PROCEDURE

<b>STEP 1</b>	<b>CLEAN</b> the tub with soap and water. Use a scrub brush.
<b>STEP 2</b>	<b>RINSE</b> with clean water.
<b>STEP 3</b>	<b>DISINFECT</b> tub with an intermediate-level disinfectant. Spray thoroughly and follow the manufacturer's instructions. Keep the surface wet for required time to allow for disinfection (contact time).

### ADDITIONAL NOTES

- ✓ Clean and disinfect filter/screen (including magnetic) between clients. Take apart screens.
- ✓ Clean and soak scrub brush (used in step 1) in disinfectant daily; and allow it to dry.
- ✓ Use only Health Canada-approved disinfectants.
- ✓ An [intermediate-level disinfectant](#) may be used for footbath disinfection per the steps above.
- ✓ Follow the manufacturer's instructions for all equipment and disinfectants.
- ✓ If using a liner:
  - Clean/disinfect the tub with a with low-level disinfectant daily.
  - **If no liner or liner tears**, disinfect with intermediate-level disinfectant **between clients**.
