JAN 12

- SMDHU offers boosters for those 18+ years

JAN 6

- SMDHU offers boosters for those 40+ years

JAN 3

- SMDHU offers J&J vaccine at 15 Sperling

JAN 17

- SMDHU rescinds Section 22

JAN 31

- Ontario implements "cautious approach to reopening"

FEB 17

- Ontario lifts capacity limits

MAR 21

- Ontario lifts masking requirements in most public settings

FEB 22

- SMDHU offers COVID-19 vaccine clinics in schools for 5-11 years

FEB 18

- SMDHU offers boosters for 12-17 years

APR 7

- SMDHU offers second boosters (4th doses) for all Indigenous adults

APR 13

- SMDHU closes all but one community vaccination clinic, continues pop-up clinics

APR 20

- SMDHU offers COVID-19 vaccine clinics in schools for 5-11 years

SEP 12

- At-risk Ontarians eligible for bivalent booster

SEP 1

- SMDHU offers boosters for 5-11 years

MAY 31

- COVID-19 vaccine clinics start in local health unit offices

SEP 26

- All Ontarians 18+ eligible for bivalent booster

OCT 13

- All Ontarians 12+ eligible for bivalent booster

DEC 21

- 5-11 years eligible for bivalent booster
