Bat Capture Kit for Recreational Camps

- Gloves (heavy, preferably pliable thick leather)
- Forceps (9" to 12" length, rat-tooth for gripping)
- Extension pole w/net (fine mesh insect net of polyester or muslin material with a spring steel hoop on telescoping pole -- net and pole sold separately)
- Coffee can w/tight-fitting lid or similar container (e.g., cardboard ice cream carton w/lid; keep multiple containers on hand)
- Sheet of cardboard to slide between wall and container to act as a lid
- Tape (to secure lid on container)
- Flashlights (including fresh batteries & extra batteries)
- General Guidelines for Management of Bat-Related Incidents at Recreational Camps (3 copies)
 - 1. one copy in Bat Capture Kit
 - 2. one laminated copy for display in staff area
 - 3. one copy for the camp policy and procedure manual

How to Safely Capture a Bat

- When bat lands, approach it slowly
- While wearing gloves place container over bat
- Slide cardboard under the container to trap bat inside
- Tape cardboard securely
- Contact local health unit
