- <u>Chronic Disease Prevention</u> Food and nutrition, and physical activity
- <u>Environmental Health Hazards</u> Air quality, extreme weather, climate change, environmental contaminants, food safety, and safe water
- <u>Injury Prevention</u> Falls prevention and concussion
- Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) guidance in office and community care
- Mental Health Self-injury and suicide awareness/life promotion
- Oral Health Publicly-funded dental care programs
- Outbreaks Outbreak guidance and forms, and a listing of current outbreaks
- <u>Parent and Child Health</u> Preconception, pregnancy, postpartum, breastfeeding, early childhood health, parenting, and the Healthy Babies Healthy Children home-visiting program
- Social Prescribing Connecting patients with non-medical community resources
- Substance Use Alcohol, cannabis, opioids and other unregulated drugs, and smoking and vaping
- <u>HealthSTATS</u> Local health status and demographic data
