As soon as you recognize an increase in illness at your facility, call SMDHU to consult 1-877-721-7520 or 705-721-7520 (Monday to Friday, 08:30 am to 4:30 pm) Contact your liaison or call the infectious diseases line at ext. 8809 After hours, weekends, and holidays call the ID investigator on-call at 1-888-225-7851 ☐ Isolate symptomatic residents and exclude symptomatic staff and volunteers. ☐ Initiate separate resident and staff line lists (enteric / respiratory). ☐ Call SMDHU. ☐ Review and complete the enteric or respiratory OB checklist and initiate all recommendations. ☐ Upload or fax (705-733-7738) the line lists and completed checklist. ☐ Collect specimens and put OB number on the completed lab requisitions. ☐ Arrange with SMDHU for courier delivery to the Public Health Laboratory. ☐ Notify facility OB management team.

How Long to Isolate?

Enteric Cases:

• Until 48 hours symptom free or in consultation with ICP or SMDHU liaison

Respiratory (all viruses except COVID-19):

• 5 days from symptom onset or when symptoms have resolved whichever is shorter. Encourage masking for 10 days from symptom onset.

COVID-19 Cases:

• Minimum of 5 days from symptom onset; and until symptoms are resolving x 24 hours. Mask for 10 days from symptom onset (remain in precautions if resident is unable to mask).

Respiratory Contacts:

- Roommates with ongoing exposure to be on Additional Precautions for 5 days, then masking until day 10.
- Non-roommate: masking for 7 days
