## Influenza Vaccine Planning 2017

- Attention: Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, Long-Term Care Homes, Rest & Retirement Homes, Walk-in Clinics, Hospitals, Infection Control Practitioners, Correctional Facilities, Participating Health Care Agencies, Participating UIIP Pharmacies
- Date: September 8, 2017

With influenza vaccine season approaching, we are receiving many inquiries about when the Universal Influenza Immunization Program (UIIP) Health Fax and order form will be ready. Please be aware that we are still awaiting final details on this year's UIIP from the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care.

As soon as this year's information is confirmed, we will send out our annual UIIP health fax, with this year's Influenza Vaccine Order Form, vaccine pick up dates, and vaccine availability.

Only Influenza vaccine orders that are submitted on this year's Influenza Vaccine Order Form will be filled.

For **<u>tentative</u>** planning purposes we are anticipating the following:

- Primary care providers, long term care homes and hospitals will likely be able to start to pick-up vaccine for their high risk patients starting the week of October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
- Other health care agencies (i.e. nursing agencies, workplaces) and vaccine for the general population will likely be available starting the week of October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017.

Approved pharmacies will be providing the flu vaccine again this year in Ontario. They will receive their vaccine directly from the Ontario Government Pharmacy directly via their Pharmacy Distributors.

Please note that each year there is always the possibility of supply chain issues. If this occurs, you will be notified as there maybe changes to order and pick-up dates.
