Correction - Multi-Dose Vials of Flu Vaccine & Thimerosal and Flu Vaccine Supply Update

It has come to our attention that there was an error in the table below in our Annual UIIP Healthfax. As in previous years, all multi dose vials (MDV) of influenza vaccine contain trace amounts of Thimerosal as a preservative. Therefore, Thimerosal is a potential allergen in the MDV format of both Fluzone® Quadrivalent and FluLaval® Tetra.

*According to NACI, egg-allergic individuals may be vaccinated against influenza using the full dose of any appropriate product, including QIV, Q-LAIV and high-dose TIV.

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Influenza Vaccine Supply Updates

Replenishment Orders of Flu Vaccine

The health unit will be receiving our first replenishment order of influenza vaccine on October 26th. **Orders received for more flu vaccine by 3pm on Tuesday October 23rd will be available for pick up on Tuesday October 30th.** Vaccine will continue to be available to order weekly as needed thereafter. Note that private pharmacies do not receive their influenza vaccine from the health unit, as the provincial government has a separate supply chain for them.

All providers are only to stock a one to two week supply of influenza vaccine. This is to prevent large amounts of vaccine wastage as a result of a power outage or fridge malfunction. The package sizes of some products may also impact fridge space. Health unit staff may adjust orders taking into account your current inventory, the size of your vaccine fridge and current vaccine supply.

If there is a reason you are ordering a large amount of vaccine (i.e. you have a clinic booked), please note this on the order form so that staff can take this into account when reviewing your order.

High Dose Fluzone® Vaccine (for those 65+ years of age)

There is only a limited supply of this vaccine (25,000 doses for all of Simcoe Muskoka) available. We allocated this vaccine initially to those living in LTCHs, those in hospital and those living in Rest and Retirement Homes. The remaining supply is being distributed equitably to all Primary Care Providers for their patients.

There will not be enough of this vaccine for every person 65+ and people should not wait to see if it's available. It is most important that people receive their flu vaccine as soon as it is available, and the health unit does not recommend delaying anyone's flu immunization and chance missing the opportunity for them to be immunized.

This vaccine is not available through the pharmacies participating in the UIIP.

FluMist® Quadrivalent Vaccine

The health unit has not yet received our supply of FluMist® vaccine. For those who order this vaccine by **3pm on Tuesday October 23rd, it will be available in orders ready for pick up Tuesday October 30th.** There is a limited supply of this vaccine as well (1,000 doses for all of Simcoe Muskoka). The supply will be distributed as equitably as possible to Primary Care Providers. The pharmacy distributors also received a limited supply of this vaccine, so it may be available at local pharmacies. Pharmacists can only administer this vaccine to those 5 through 17 years of age.
