SMDHU COVID-19 Epidemiological Update

On June 18, the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit (SMDHU) saw 25 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Simcoe Muskoka. This is the highest single day increase in cases since the pandemic began. Twenty-three of the newly reported cases reside in Simcoe County and two in Muskoka. Nine cases are associated with an outbreak on a farm in Simcoe County, and the remainder are sporadic (i.e. not associated with that outbreak: 10 community acquired; five close contacts of a case, one undetermined). Eleven of these individuals were asymptomatic (i.e. have no symptoms).

This is yet another reminder of how important it is that we continue to stay the course with our measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 as the province reopens. We must all continue to practise physical distancing, hand sanitization, and use of masks when two metres of physical distance cannot be maintained (e.g. small retail settings, public transit), and to self-isolate and seek assessment and testing if you develop symptoms. For clinical encounters with patients with no COVID symptoms or acquisition risk factors, in order to prevent asymptomatic transmission, please universally wear a surgical/procedural mask and eye protection.

The most current case counts for laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases in the Simcoe Muskoka District Health (SMDHU) region are available at Simcoe Muskoka Health Stats i.

The SMDHU has created a new resource entitled "Tested! Now What?" ii which provides instructions to patients on next steps following having a COVID-19 test completed.
