Change to Vaccine Ordering Timelines

Date: January 11, 2019

Due to a change in the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit's weekly delivery day from the Ontario Government Pharmacy (OGP), we have had to alter the timelines for processing vaccine orders.

On a permanent basis, Order/Pick-Up Day is being changed from Tuesday to Wednesday.

Vaccine orders received by Wednesday at 3:00 pm will be ready for pick up in your specified health unit office by the following Wednesday. The fax numbers and ordering process remain the same.

Beginning the week of February 4, 2019, orders will need to be placed by Wednesday February 6th, no later than 3:00 p.m. to pick up the morning of Wednesday February 13th, 2019.
