

Tarmac Stencils Information

Encouraging children to be active at recess is important! They will be more ready to learn...Make your schoolyard inviting and watch what happens!

The Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit has purchased a set of tarmac stencils that schools can borrow. These stencils can be borrowed on a first come, first served basis on a short-term loan as they are in demand. Lending Instructions

To borrow the stencils please fill out the Tarmac Stencil Loan Form (request from SchoolHealth@smdhu.org) and identify requested pick-up and return dates.

Please note that sharing of stencils between schools is not permitted.

Pick up and Return Information:

Location: Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit office at **15 Sperling Dr., Barrie, ON L4M 6K9**, Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm.

- Bring a large utility van or open bed pick-up truck/trailer. The Tarmac Stencils are very large and are stored in flat cardboard boxes measuring approximately 6 feet by 8 feet.
- Bring two people. The boxes are not heavy but due to their size, they are awkward to move and thus require two people to lift them to ensure they are not damaged. If you note any damage to the Tarmac Stencils, please notify our staff so we can arrange repair.
- Before returning the stencils, ensure dirt/gravel grit is removed, wipe down hard surfaces with Lysol wipes before packing in their boxes, and ensure the boxes are **secured taped closed**.

Playground Layout and Painting Instructions

You will need to purchase traffic paint for use with the stencils. It costs approximately \$5 per can. Each stencil requires a different amount of paint. See the information about each stencil in the pages below. Traffic paint can be purchased at many suppliers, one supplier is Fastline:

1. Choose the area where you would like to paint your playground games.
2. Ensure that the dimension of the games that you have chosen will fit in your chosen space.
3. Painting surface must be clear of debris; rocks, dirt, etc.
4. When painting outside, best results will be achieved on a dry day when the temperature is above 5° Celsius and there is very little or no wind.
5. Lay out your stencil as you want it to appear. Some stencils will require assembly. Lay down the pieces and use masking tape to hold the pieces together. Stencils may be taped or weighted down to the tarmac to hold them securely in place while you are painting.
6. Follow all of the necessary safety precautions when using spray paint. Face masks, gloves, eye goggles and protective layers for shoes and clothes are recommended.
7. Spray the paint in the open sections of the stencil. Two thin layers of paint are better than one thick coat. Allow the paint to dry between coats and before lifting the stencil.
8. It will usually take a few volunteers a few hours to complete the painting and clean up.
9. Remove any tape, and allow paint to dry on stencil(s) before wiping with Lysol wipes and placing back in the carton that it came in.
