Dear Mayor Orsi and Council, Re: Public consultations into community water fluoridation

- 1. Get to the point quickly: Let council know you support a decision to implement fluoridation of Orillia's municipal drinking water.
- 2. State why you support fluoridation: Do you have a personal reason you would like to relate? Have you seen first-hand how fluoridation works, or you know the results of poor dental health on a friend or family member? Maybe your concern is for the whole community and its wellbeing. Councillors really do want to hear your point of view, in your own words.
- 3. Conclude with a few words about the outcome: Express how you feel Council's decision will affect the city, or how this event will be seen in the future. And as a courtesy, thank Council for allowing your input.
